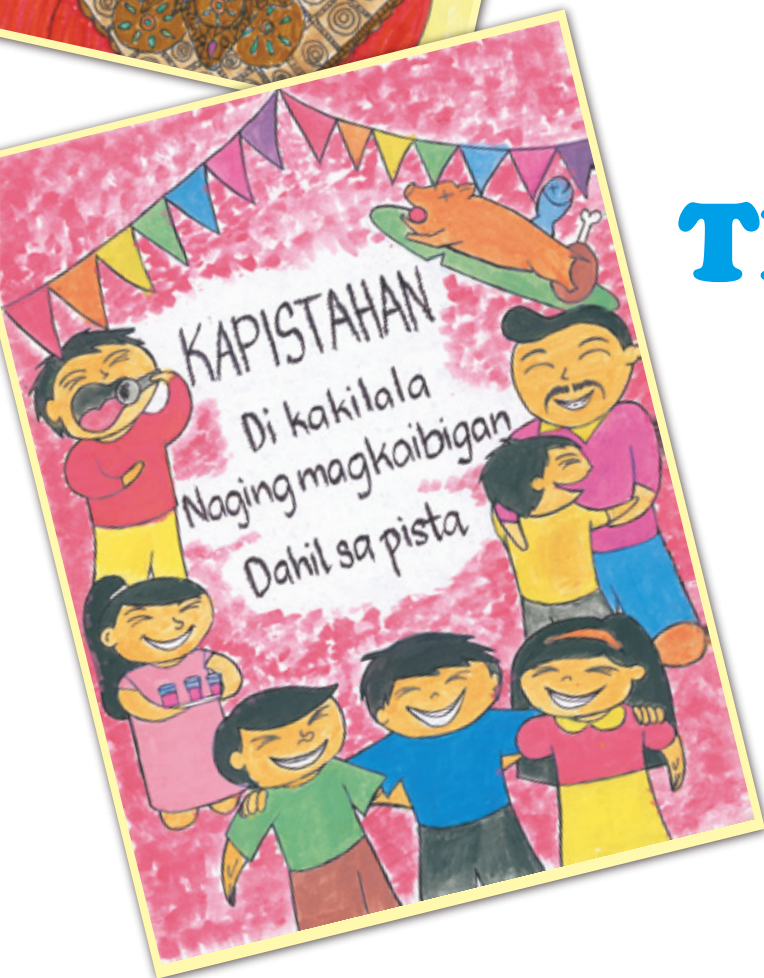

#### Applications:

- One entry per student (either typed or handwritten) on the theme of Dreams
- Applicants must be primary or secondary school students aged 15 or under
- The haiku must be accompanied by hand-drawn/hand-crafted artwork on the same page using A4 sized (210mm x 297mm) paper or larger
- Glue the application form on the back of the work

#### Composition:

- Any form of artwork (except photographs or digital images) can be accepted, e.g., water / oil paints, coloured or black and white, wood-cut print, paper cuttings etc
- Please ensure it is your original unpublished work
- The Haiku must be 3 lines long (there is no need for it to rhyme)
- All rights of entry (composition and artwork) will be reserved by JAL Foundation
