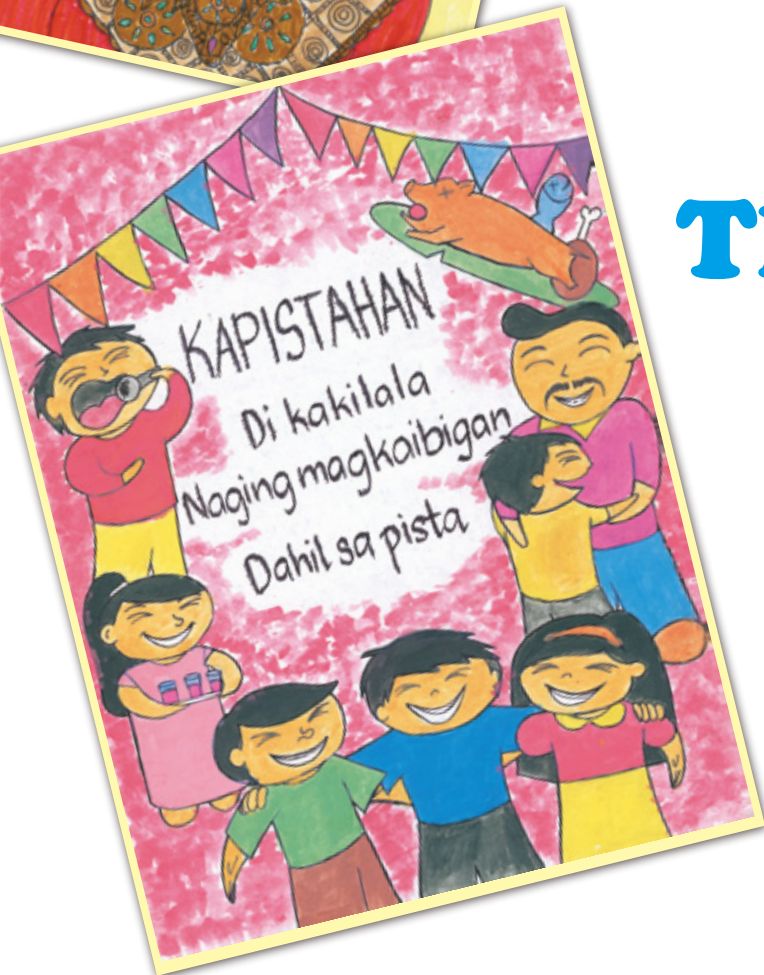

Haiku Competition Rules

Applications:

- One entry per student (either typed or handwritten) on the theme of Dreams
- Applicants must be elementary or middle school students aged 15 and under
- The haiku must be written in English and be 3 lines long accompanied by hand-drawn or handcrafted artwork on the same paper, using letter-sized paper or larger (Max. 11 1/2" x 16 1/2")
- Name, sex, age, address/contact information must be written legibly on the back of each entry
- Glue the application form on the back of the work

Composition:

- Any form of original artwork can be accepted, e.g., water/oil paints, colored or black and white, wood-cut print, paper cuttings etc. (Note: photographs or digital images can not be accepted)
- Please ensure it is your original unpublished work
- All rights of entry (composition and artwork) will be reserved by JAL Foundation

Awards/Prizes:

Award recognition and gifts for winning & outstanding haikus; winning author's haiku will be included in a published collection
