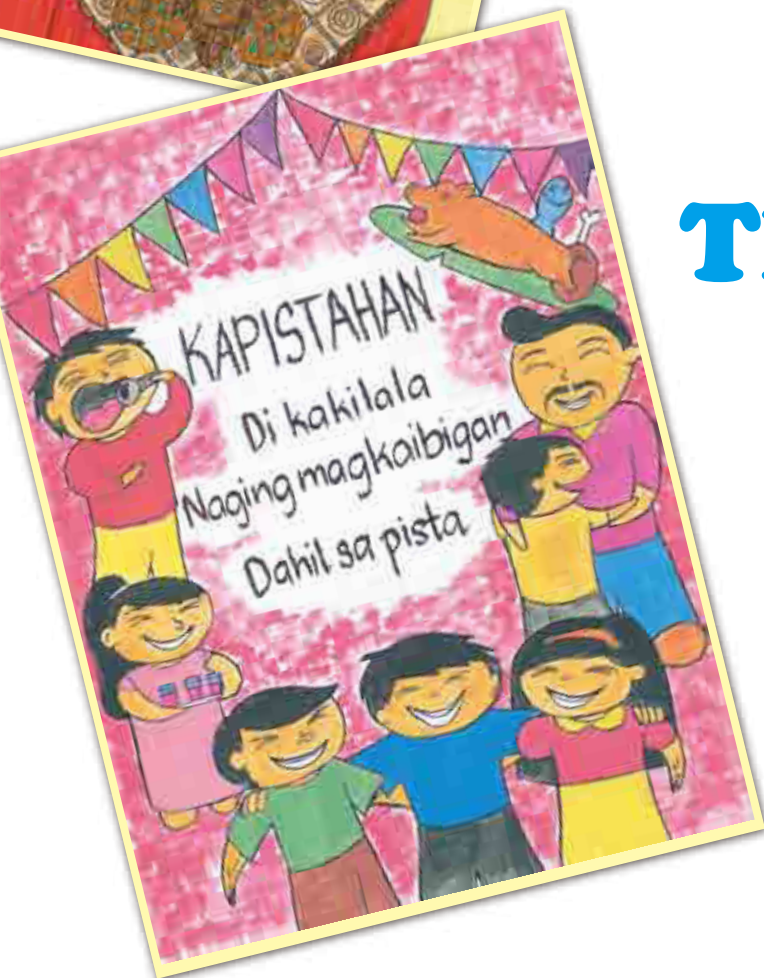

- Applicants must be primary or secondary school students aged 15 or under

- Please write the applicant's name and age on the back of the work

Composition:

- Any form of artwork (except photograph or digital images) can be accepted eg; water/oil paints, coloured or black and white, wood-cut print, paper cuttings etc
- Please ensure it is your original unpublished work
- The haiku must be 3 lines long (there is no need for it to rhyme)
- All rights of entry (composition and artwork) will be reserved by JAL Foundation
