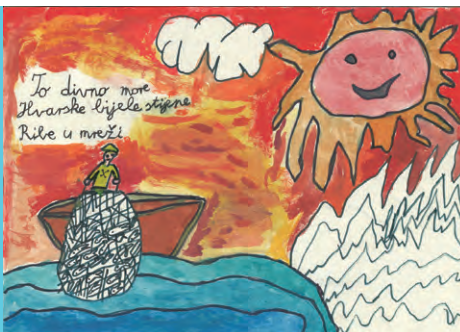

Applications	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● One entry per child (either typed or handwritten) on the theme of "Family". ● Applicants must be the age of 15 and under on January 15, 2024. ● The haiku must be accompanied by hand-drawn or hand-crafted artwork on the same page, using A4-sized paper (21 cm x 29.7cm) or letter-sized paper (8.5in. x 11 in.). ● Glue the application form on the back of the work. 	Submission Period	October 1, 2023 ~January 15, 2024
Composition	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Any form of artwork (except photographs or digital images) can be submitted. ● Every entry must be the original and unpublished work of the child himself/herself. Assistance by others (parents, other adults, siblings, or other children) is prohibited. ● The haiku must be presented in three short lines in English. ● All rights (for compositions and artwork) will be reserved by JAL Foundation. 	Special award ceremony	To be held in July 2024.

Winners will be announced on JAL Foundation's website and receive a certificate and prize.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Use this application form</p> <p>Regional contests (in local language) Results to be announced in Jun. 2024</p> <p>Works in local languages other than Japanese may be submitted from various regions. Winners will be selected for each region and receive a certificate and prize.</p> <p>Winners of the Gold, Silver, and Bronze awards will be invited to an award ceremony in Tokyo. Winners will be decided by a panel of judges organized by JAL Foundation. Each will receive ¥100,000 as grant money for travel and accommodation expenses in Japan.
