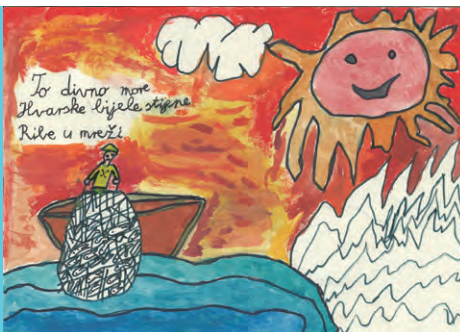

<b>Applications</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● One entry per child (either typed or handwritten) on the theme of "Family".</li> <li>● Applicants must be the age of 15 and under on January 15, 2024.</li> <li>● The haiku must be accompanied by hand-drawn or hand-crafted artwork on the same page, using A4-sized paper (21 cm x 29.7 cm) or letter-sized paper (8.5 in. x 11 in.).</li> <li>● Glue the application form on the back of the work.</li> </ul>	<b>Submission Period</b>	<b>October 1, 2023 ~ January 15, 2024</b>
<b>Composition</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Any form of artwork (except photographs or digital images) can be submitted.</li> <li>● Every entry must be the original and unpublished work of the child himself/herself. Assistance by others (parents, other adults, siblings, or other children) is prohibited.</li> <li>● The haiku must be presented in three short lines.</li> <li>● All rights (for compositions and artwork) will be reserved by JAL Foundation.</li> </ul>	<b>Special award ceremony</b>	<b>To be held in July 2024.</b>

Winners will be announced on JAL Foundation's website and receive a certificate and prize.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Use this application form</b></p> <p><b>Regional contests (in local language)</b> Results to be announced in Jun. 2024.</p> <p>Works in local languages other than Japanese may be submitted from various regions. Winners will be selected for each region and receive a certificate and prize.</p> </div> <div style="width: 35%; background-color: #333; color: white; padding: 10px; border-radius: 10px;"> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Special awards</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>One Gold, Silver, and Bronze award winner</b></p> <p>From among the Grand Prize winners of the Japanese Language Contest and Regional Contest, three most outstanding works overall will be selected.</p> </div> </div> <p>Winners of the Gold, Silver, and Bronze awards will be invited to an award ceremony in Tokyo. Winners will be decided by a panel of judges organized by JAL Foundation. Each will receive ¥100,000 as grant money for travel and accommodation expenses in Japan.
