Applications	 One entry per child(either typed or handwritten) on the theme of "Family". Applicants must be the age of 15 and under on January 15, 2024. The haiku must be accompanied by hand-drawn or hand-crafted artwork on the same page, using A4-sized paper(21 cm x 29.7cm) or letter-sized paper (8.5in. x 11 in.). Glue the application form on the back of the work. 	Submission Period	October 1, ~January	
Composition	 Any form of artwork(except photographs or digital images) can be submitted. Every entry must be the original and unpublished work of the child himself/herself. Assistance by others(parents, other adults, siblings, or other children) is prohibited. The haiku must be presented in three short lines.
