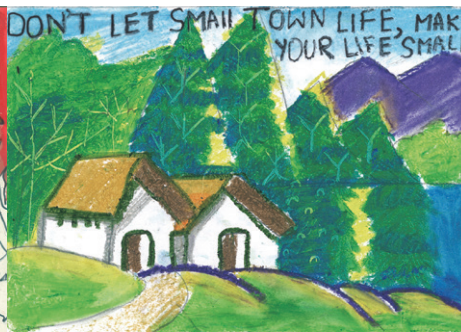

Winners will be decided by a panel of judges organized by JAL Foundation.
