The haiku must be accompanied by hand-drawn or hand-crafted artwork on the same page, using A4-sized paper(21 cm x 29.7cm) or letter-sized paper (8.5in. x 11 in.). Composition	 Any form of artwork(except photographs or digital images) can be submitted. Every entry must be the original and unpublished work of the child himself/herself. Assistance by others(parents, other adults, siblings, or other children) is prohibited. The haiku must be presented in three short lines.
