October 1, 2023 Submission **Applications** •The haiku must be accompanied by hand-drawn or hand-crafted artwork on the same Period ~January 15, 2024 page, using A4-sized paper(21 cm x 29.7cm) or letter-sized paper (8.5in. x 11 in.). •Glue the application form on the back of the work. •Any form of artwork(except photographs or digital images) can be submitted. • Every entry must be the original and unpublished work of the child himself/herself. To be held in Special award Composition Assistance by others(parents, other adults, siblings, or other children) is prohibited. ceremony July 2024. •The haiku must be presented in three short lines. •All rights(for compositions and artwork) will be reserved by JAL Foundation.
